

## Proposed changes to the conservation area

The Bardsey conservation area was first designated in 1975. As part of this appraisal the conservation area boundary has been reviewed and a number of changes are proposed to ensure it best represents the special architectural and historic interest of Bardsey-cum-Rigton.

Proposed changes to the boundary include:

- Areas of extension at East Rigton and Rowley Grange and Wayside Gardens.
- An extension to include the Corn Mill, Old Forge and remains of a railway bridge, Cornmill Lane.
- Extension to include 6, 8, 10 & 12 Church Lane.
- An extension to include the Village Hall and Woodacre Crescent.
- Area of extension to include 46 and 48 Church Lane, 3 Blackmoor Lane, Bardsey Lodge and Tithe Barn Lane.
- Some boundary rationalisation to exclude a number of late 20th and early 21st century residences that are not of special architectural interest.
